*People of Faith* is short but makes a statement about putting faith, hope, and love into practice in our lives.


*Yet I Will Rejoice* is a setting of Hab 3:17-18. It has long been one of my favorite passages.



# PEOPLE OF FAITH




Peo-ple of faith rise up and sing. This is the psalm to God we bring. Our song we
